Commodity EXIM Report

DGCI & S, I T J Division

The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns w.r.t. selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for better policy making.

2. For both categories of trades, one commodity group is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2023-2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for Export and Import Operations. While India specific data is sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C & I Database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-Comtrade Database.

3. As regards the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years. Currently (for reports being prepared in FY 2023- 2024) we are considering the time-period of 2020-2021 to 2023-2024(Financial year data). The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade Database is only up to year 2023 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S Database up to May,2024. So, for each commodity group dealt in this report, trends from 2020 to 2023 have been showcased where data has been sourced from UN Comtrade and from 2020-2021 to 2023-2024 when sourced from DGCI&S database; however, for computation of commodity group's share in India's overall export basket and import basket we have had to use FY (financial year) data as all aggregate level data in India are represented in FY format.

4. In the instant report [5th weekly Commodity Exim Report of May,2024 dated 29th May, 2024] the following two commodities have been dealt with.

Export : Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc [ITCHS Code –6204] -In FY 2023-2024 (April,2023 –March,2024) this commodity group has 0.64% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S data base. India had occupied the top slot in export of this commodity (2876.78 million USD) with 4.64% share of total global exports in the year 2023-2024.

Import : Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil [ITCHS Code –2713] –In FY 2023-24 (April 2023 – March,2024) this commodity group had share of 0.52% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S data base. India having 14.36% share of total global imports of this commodity (3739.77 million USD) occupied the 2nd slot in the world in 2023.

EXPORT

Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc. classified as H.S. Code – 6204 falls under Chapter -62(Articles of apparel and clothing accessories, not knitted or crocheted) of Section XI (Textile and Textile Articles) of ITC-HS classification. Chapter 62 contributes significantly to India's export earnings especially in recent few years. India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2023-2024 FY this commodity group has so far (April,2023-March, 2024) had 0.64% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S data base.

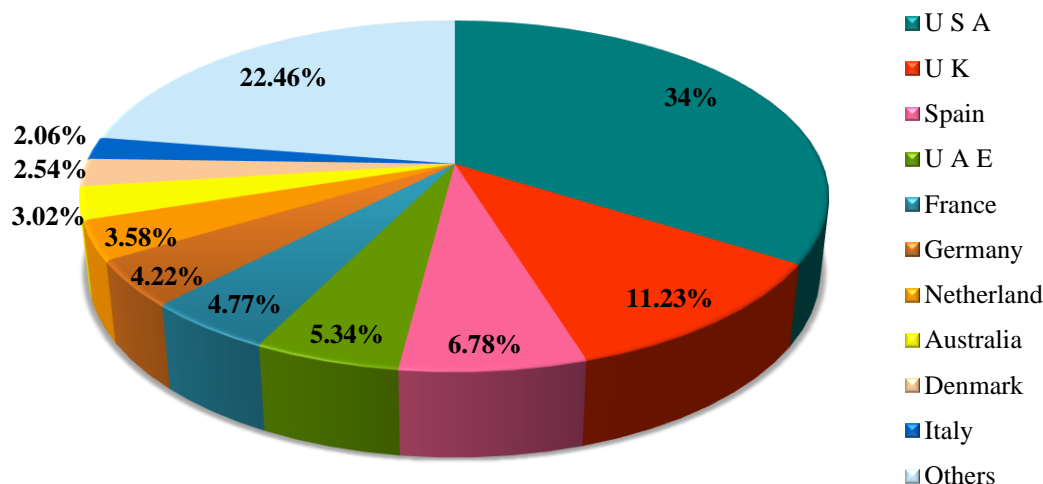

India's top 10 destinations of Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc by percentage share in 2023-2024



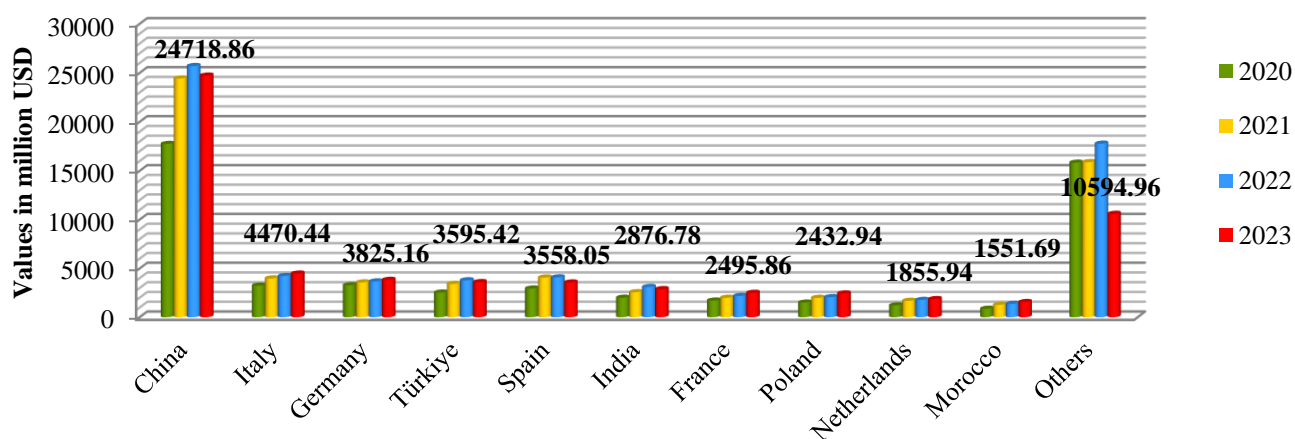
In the year 2023-2024 India had exported Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc worth of US\$ 2838.02 million and registered a decrease of 9.65% compared to 2022-2023 figures of US \$ 3140.88 million. USA (importing US\$ 964.88 million worth of goods in this segment from India) has held the top slot as an export destination in this segment from India with a significant 34% share of India's total exports in this segment recorded for the year 2023-2024. In second and third place were UK (US\$ 318.64 million) and Spain (US\$ 192.50 million) to where India exported around 11.23% and 6.78% of the commodity respectively in 2023-2024.

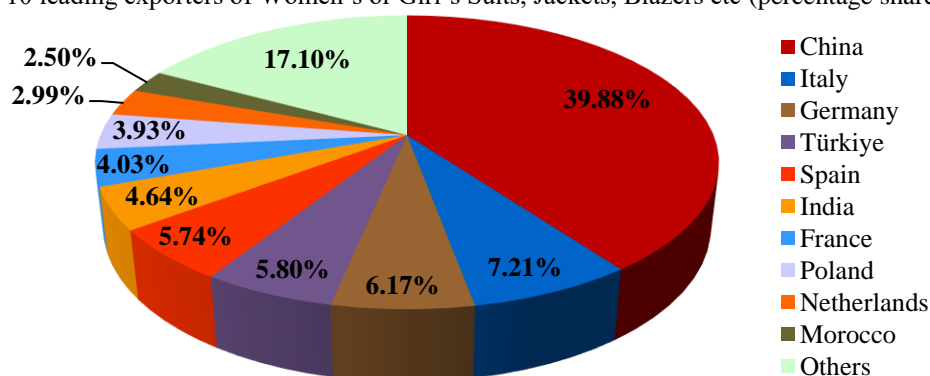

World's 10 leading exporters of Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc (percentage share in 2023):



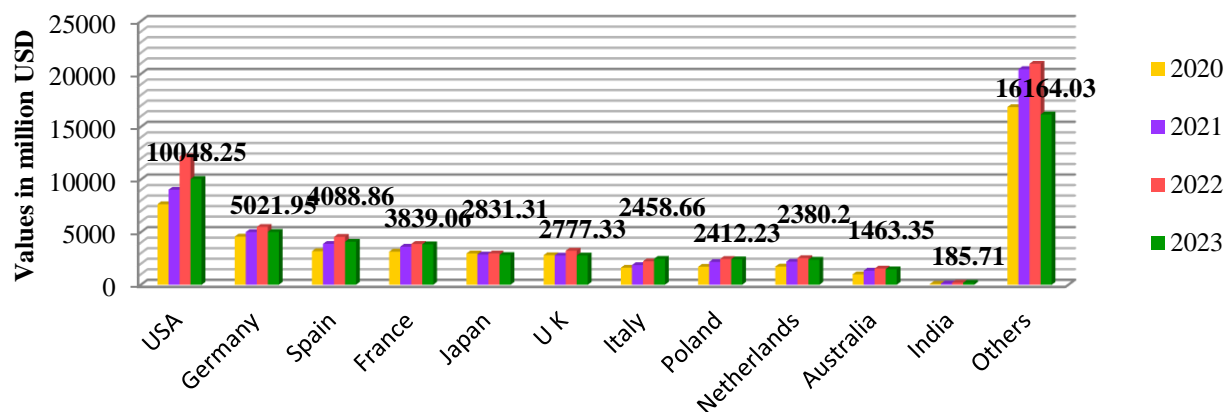
The Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc exports worldwide was US\$ 61976.10 million in 2023, with a decrease by 11.06% compared to 2022 level. Over the period under review, global exports, were at record high at US \$ 69682.09 million in 2022. **India** (exporting goods worth a total of US\$ 2876.78 million in this category) with a show of 4.64% share, stood at 6th position globally. The lead exporter in this segment was China (US\$ 24718.86 million) with 39.88% share of world exports followed by Italy (US\$ 4470.44 million) with 7.21% and Germany (US\$ 3825.16 million) with 6.17% share in 2023 respectively. India's performance has significantly improved over the years, however, in percentage share terms, India's share has remained limited around more or less 4% mark.

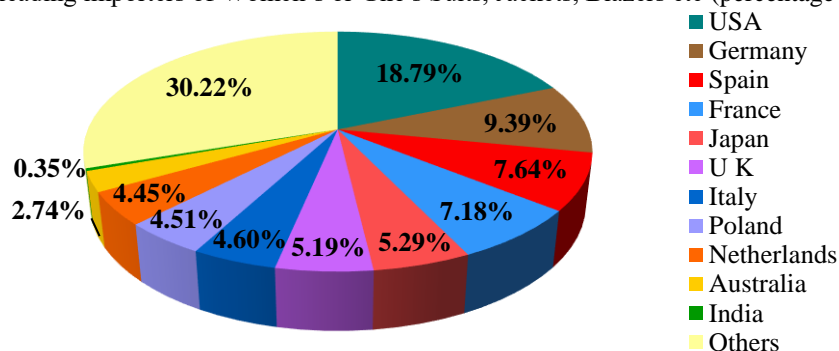

Data labels signified for 2023



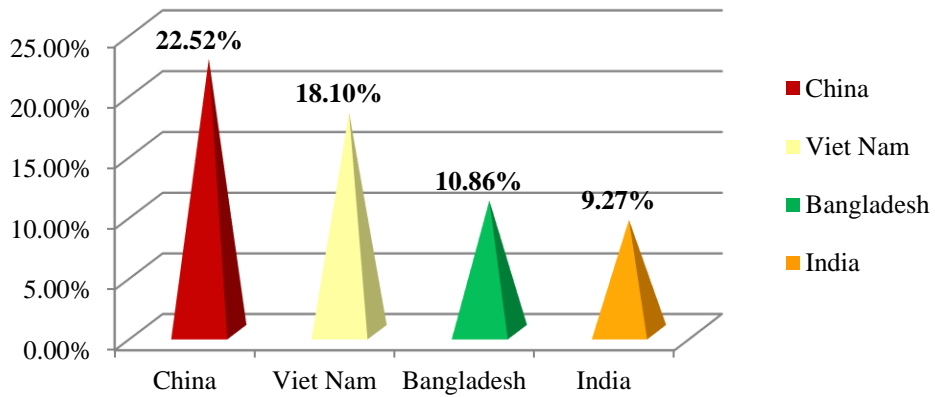
World's 10 leading importers of Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc (percentage share in 2022)



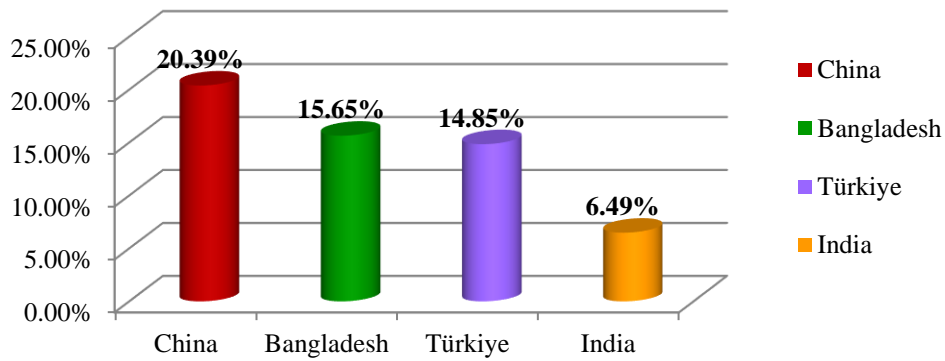
The Women's or Girl's Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc imports worldwide was US\$ 53485.23 million in 2023, decreasing by 13.79 % from 2022 levels. The lead importers in this segment in 2022 have been USA (18.79%), Germany (9.39%), and Spain (7.64%). **India** with a show of only 0.35% share in this category, stood at 35th position globally. Global import value in this segment has steadily increased from 2020 till 2022 and then dip in 2023. The 2nd and 3rd largest importers of this product are Germany and Spain, on the other hand these 2 nations are also the leading exporters of this products in the world with variations in their ranking within top 10. A difference is observed between global exports and global imports of this segment as recorded in UN Comtrade database. In 2023 global exports exceeded global imports by US\$ 8490.87 million.

As per UN Comtrade data base the top 3 importers of Women’s or Girl’s Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc globally were **USA, Germany and Spain**. These 3 countries had imported 9.27%, 6.49% and 5.22% share of their total import of this commodity from India in 2023 which are presented below:

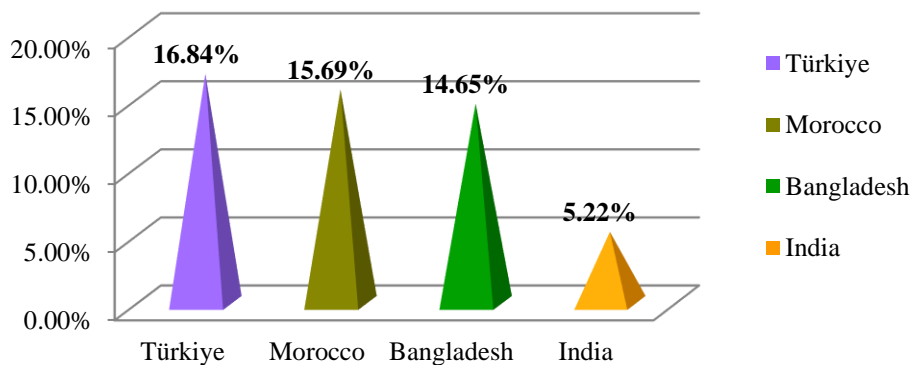
(i) Top 3 supplier nations of Women’s or Girl’s Suits, Jackets, Blazers etc to USA in 2023 (percentage share)

IMPORT

Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil classified as ITCCHS Code – 2713 falls under Chapter -27 (Mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of Section – V (Mineral Products) as per ITC–HS Classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in 2023-2024 this commodity group had share of 1.30% in India's total import value basket as per DGCI&S data base. Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil is one of India's important imported items.

The total amount of India's import in this segment in 2023-2024 stood as US\$ 3526.22 million registering a moderate decrease by 17.58% over 2022-2023 figures of US\$ 4278.30 million. Belgium has persistently been India's lead import- country partner in this segment as observed from 2020 to 2023. 29.58% share of India's total imports of Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil was sourced from Belgium in 2023, followed next by Bhutan and Japan with shares of 26.06% and 10.04% respectively. India's import value in this segment has been steadily increasing from US\$ 1675.48 million in 2020 to US\$ 4278.30 million in 2022 followed by a moderate observable decline now in 2023.

It is observed that out of 10 leading source country partners 6 countries are Asian nations from where India imported Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil.

Worldwide import of Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen and other Residues of Petroleum Oil totalled to US\$ 26037.43 million in 2023 recording a 27.15% down over 2022 levels. **India** imported US\$ 3739.77 million worth of the commodity in 2023, making it the 2nd leading importer of the commodity group worldwide with 14.36% share of world imports. China (19.81%) and USA(10.57%) lined up in 1st and third place in 2023. Over the period under review the global imports in this segment has steadily been rising from 2020 till 2022 with a major leap in 2022 from 2021 levels just after the pandemic effect and then it is dip in 2023. India's share in the global landscape has also increased from 10.50% in 2020 to 14.36% in 2023.
