The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns w.r.t. selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for better policy making.

2. For both categories of trades, one commodity group is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for Export and Import Operations. While India specific data is sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C & I Database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRADE Database.

3. As regards the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years i.e. the time-period 2021 to 2024. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade Database is up to year 2024 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S Database up to May, 2026. So, for each commodity group dealt in this report, trends from 2021 to 2024 have been showcased where data has been sourced from UN Comtrade and from DGCI&S database. However, for computation of commodity group's share in India's overall export basket and import basket, Financial Year data has been used.

4. In this report [2nd weekly Commodity Exim Report of July, 2026 dated 8th July, 2026 the following two commodities have been dealt with.

Export: Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta (ITCHS Code – 0904) - In FY 2024-25, this commodity group had 0.32% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S data base. As per UN Comtrade data base, India had occupied the top slot in export of this commodity with (1409.56 million USD) with 28.75% share of total global exports in the year 2024.

Import: Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms (ITCHS Code – 3902) - In FY 2024-25, this commodity group had share of 0.26% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S data base. India had occupied the 6th slot in import of this commodity with (1906.12 million USD) with 4.39% share of total global imports in the year 2024 as per UN Comtrade data base.

EXPORT

Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta classified as H.S. Code – 0904 falls under Chapter -09 (Coffee, tea, mate and spices) and Section – II (Vegetable Products) of ITC-HS classification. India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in FY 2024-25, this commodity group had 0.32% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCIS data base.

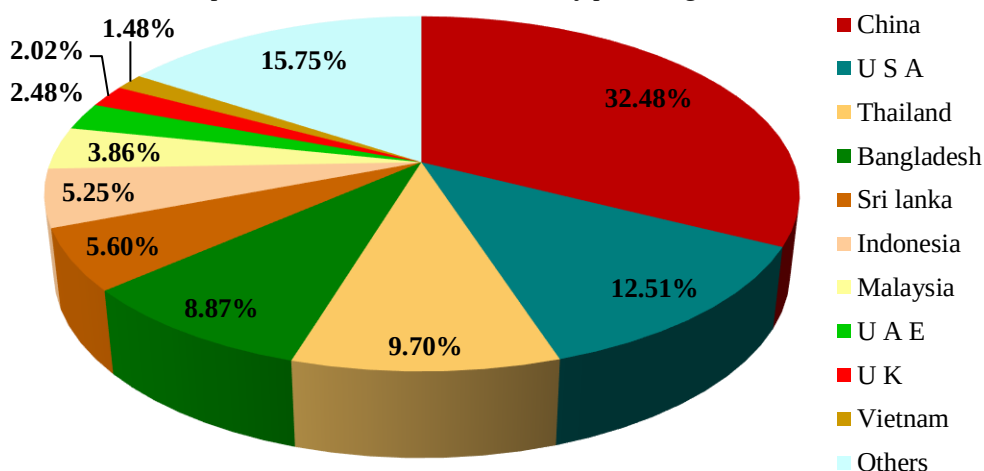

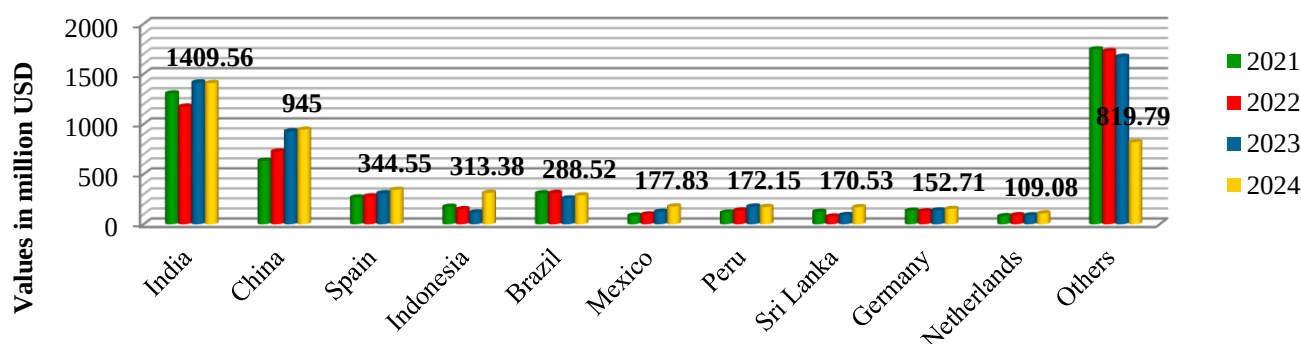
In 2024, the value of India's exports for Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta was strong, approximately US\$ 1433.66 million, marking a little growth rate of 1.26% compared to the previous year. China (importing US\$ 465.68 million) was the largest destination for Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta exports from India in 2024, with significant growth from 2023, imported 32.48% of India's total exports of Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta originating from India in the Year 2024. In second and third places were USA (US\$ 179.40 million) and Thailand (US\$ 139.10 million) to where India exported around 12.51% and 9.70% share respectively in 2024. For, the period under review, exports of Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta from India were at US\$ 1307.81 million in 2021 followed by a steep down in 2022 and after that rising trend till 2024.

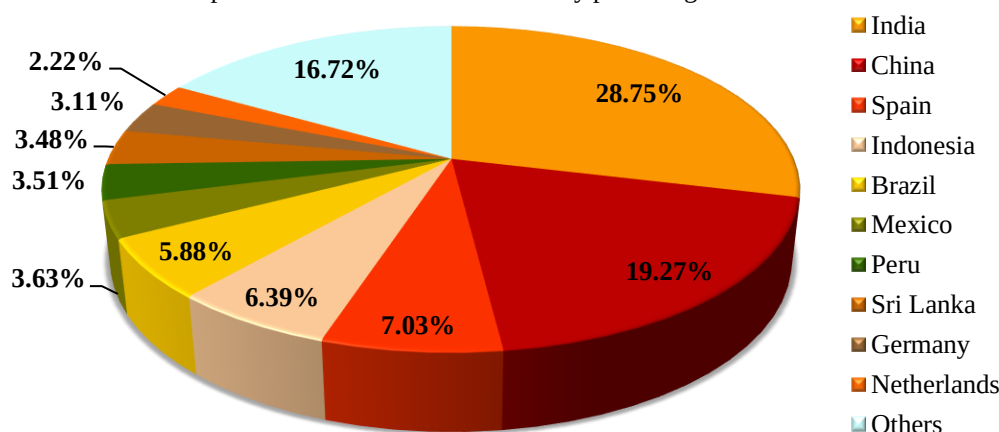

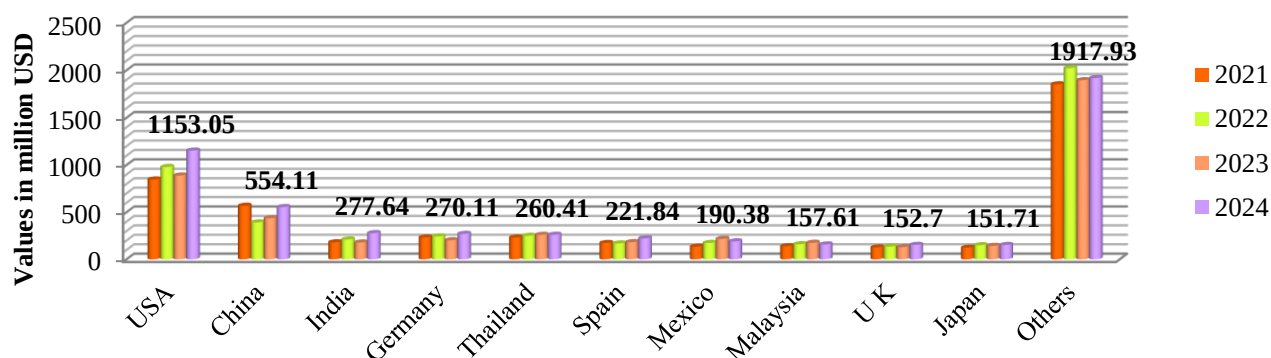
The total value of Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum or of the Genus Pimenta exported worldwide was US\$ 4903.11 million in 2024, registering a decline of 7.89% over the last year. Global exports of this commodity group experienced some fluctuations over the period under review. **India** (exporting goods worth a total of US\$ 1409.56 million in this category) with a share of 28.75%, stood at top position globally which was followed by China (US\$ 945 million) and Spain (US\$ 345.55 million) with 19.27% and 7.03% shares globally in 2024 respectively. Over the period under review, world export in this segment had little decrease in 2022 compared to the previous year, steep increase in 2023 and further experiencing a dip in 2024 compared to 2023.

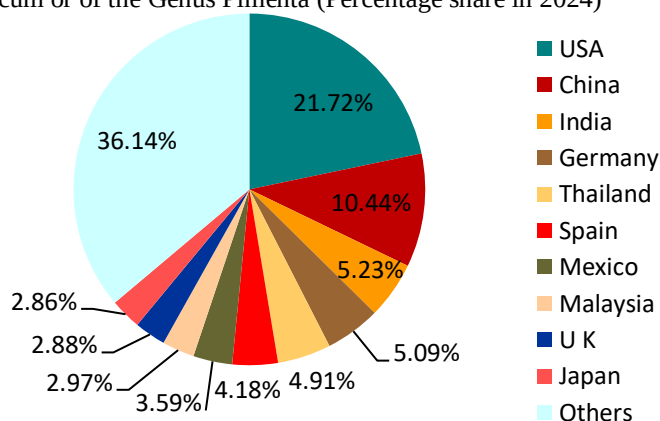

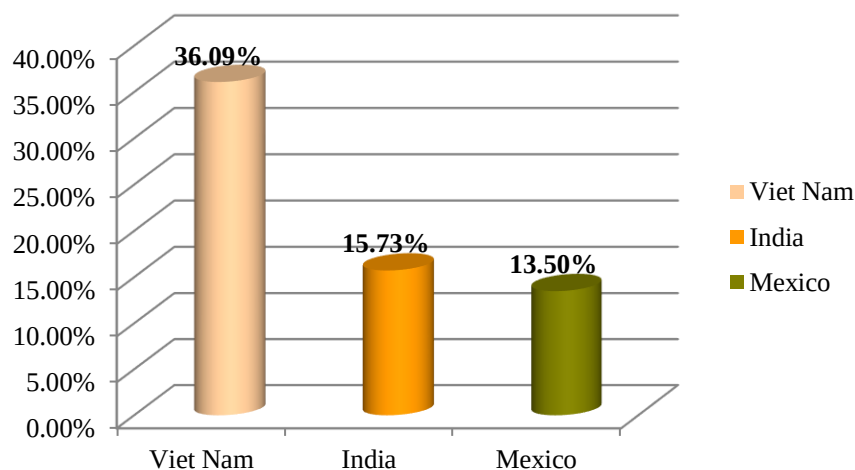

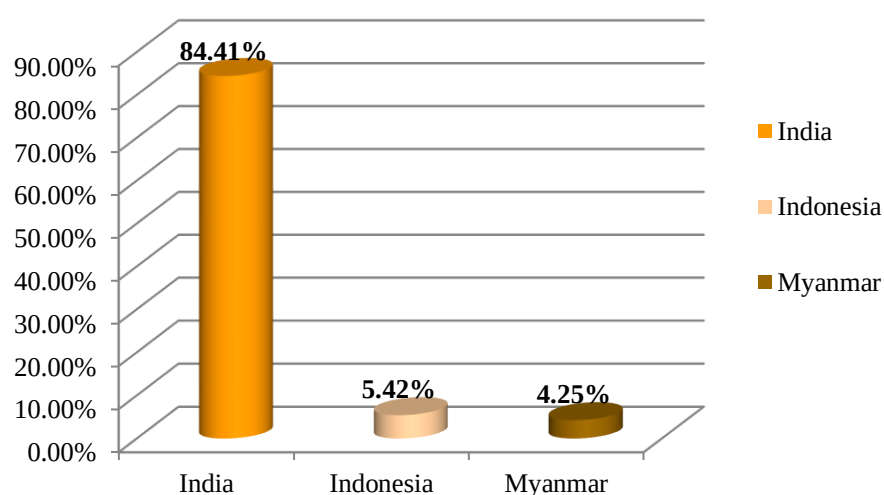
The Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum imports worldwide was US\$ 5307.49 million in 2024, increasing by 12.79% from 2023 levels. **India** (importing goods worth a total of US\$ 277.64 million in this category) with a share of 5.23%, stood at 3rd position globally. The top two importers in this segment in 2024 have been USA (21.72%), China (10.44%). India's imports in this segment had steep increase in 2022 and turned to downwards in 2023 and turned upwards in 2024.

As per UN Comtrade data base, the top 3 importers of Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum globally were **USA, China and India**. Out of these three countries, USA and China had imported 15.73% and 84.41% shares of their total import of Pepper of the Genus Piper; Dried or Crushed or ground fruits of the genus Capsicum from India in 2024 which are presented below:

IMPORT

Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms [ITC HS Code – 3902] falls under Chapter - Chapter -39 (Plastics and articles thereof) of Section- VII (Plastics and Articles Thereof; Rubber and Articles Thereof) of ITC-HS Classification. India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in FY 2024-25, this commodity group had share of 0.26% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S data base.

India's import of Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms declined by 5.94% during the year 2024, reaching US\$ 1925.90 million compared to US\$ 2047.65 million in 2023. India's top three sources of imports of Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms included countries such as UAE, Singapore and Saudi Arab. UAE had accounted for 24.63% share of India's Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms imports in 2024, followed closely by Singapore (21.88%) and Saudi Arab (15.33%). Over the period under review, India's imports in this segment were all time record high at US\$ 2143.40 million in 2022. India's import value in this segment was at US\$ 1715.48 million in 2021, followed by a steep rise in 2022 and followed continuous downwards trend till 2024.

In 2024, global trade of Polymers of Propylene or of other Olefins, in primary forms reached US\$ 43400.73 million, reflecting a little increase by 0.58% from 2023, when imports were US\$ 43151.33 million. Over the period under review, global imports were at record high at US\$ 57053.78 million in 2021 and thereafter imports declined in 2022 as well as in 2023 and experienced a little increase in 2024. China imported US\$ 4945.35 million worth of the commodity in 2024, making it the leading importer of the commodity group worldwide with 11.39% share of world imports. Türkiye (6.98%) lined up in second place in 2024 followed by Germany (6.66%). **India's** imports amounted to US\$ 1906.12 million in the year 2024 as per UN Comtrade database and **India** ranked 6th in the world with share of 4.39% of global imports.
