1.0 About Andhra Pradesh Power Generation Corporation Limited

Andhra Pradesh Power Generation Corporation Limited (APGENCO) (a Public Sector Undertaking of Andhra Pradesh) is operating 2560 MW (Dr NTTPS) at Ibrahimpatnam, Vijayawada and 1650MW (Dr MVR RTPP) at Y.S.R Cudapa Dist.

2.0 Background:

The registration of Gencos in National open access registry (NOAR) is essential for enabling them to offer their un-requisitioned surplus (URS) power in Power Exchanges as per rule (9) (1) of Electricity (Late payment surcharge and related matters). As per CERC(Connectivity and general network access to the interstate Transmission system) Regulation 2022, the Gencos will have access to the power market only when the register only on the Nation Open Access register(NOAR).

Through this EOI, APGENCO intends to identify interested and capable agencies to undertake a comprehensive study on NOAR (National Open Access Registry) procedures, infrastructure requirements for implementation, statutory approvals, regulatory compliance and assessment of benefits and challenges associated with registration of APGENCO generating units in NOAR.

3.0 Brief Scope of work

The brief scope of work consists of

- a) Study and document the procedures applicable to APGENCO thermal generating units for registration in NOAR.
- b) Assess infrastructure, hardware and software requirements for implementation of NOAR at APGENCO generating stations.
- c) Identify statutory approvals, regulatory compliances and documentation required for registration.
- d) Examine operational, commercial and regulatory implications of registration under NOAR.
- e) Identify benefits, opportunities, challenges and risks associated with participation in NOAR.
- f) Commercial impacts: Studying⁴ the tracking of financial accounting and the impact of the LATE PAYMENT SURCHARGES (LPS) dashboard on generators.

- g) Claiming/Recovery of FCA costs for URS power sold through NOAR.
- h) Provide recommendations, implementation roadmap, timelines and cost estimates.
- i) Arranging of Power point presentation at APGENCO Head quarters, Vijayawada.
- j) Submit a detailed final report along with executive summary with clarifications regarding the following points:
 - 1) Familiarisation /Structure of NOAR
 - 2) Approvals/Consents from GOAP, APPCC/APDISCOMs/APERC etc.
 - 3) Amendment to PPAs
 - 4) Process of registration in NOAR
 - 5) Registration fees, transaction charges in exchange, third party platform charges.
 - 6) Infrastructure facilities & man power required at HQ and Thermal Generating Stations.
 - 7) Detail procedure on transaction of URS in Power exchanges
 - 8) Payment settlement & security mechanism
 - 9) Technical & commercial benefits to state generators
 - 10) PENALTIES if any in case of non-offering of scheduled URS due to any constraints/failures of units on technical grounds
 - 11) Procedure of revision of Declared Capacity of units in case of non-compliance.
 - 12) Exemption of old units/Units which are not achieving 55% MTL
 - 13) Difficulties encountered during implementing & operation phases
 - 14) List of state government generators registered in NOAR.

4.0 Intent of EOI:

The intent is to identify prospective Agencies to undertake a comprehensive study on NOAR (National Open Access Registry) procedures, infrastructure requirements for implementation, statutory approvals, regulatory compliance and assessment of benefits and challenges associated with registration of APGENCO generating units in NOAR.

5.0 Eligibility

- a) The applicant should be a trading licensee, possessing valid trading license under category-III or above, granted under the provisions of Central Electricity Regulatory

Commission (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for grant of trading license and other related matters) Regulations, 2004 and Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for grant of trading license and other related matters) Regulations, 2009 as amended from time to time.

- b) Minimum 3 years of experience in power trading and regulatory consultancy.
- c) Experience in Open Access/ NOAR related assignments (desirable).
- d) The agency having executed such study to state owned utilities will be preferred.
- e) Not blacklisted by any Government/PSU/Regulatory Authority.
- f) Minimum net worth of company should be Rs 20 crores.
- g) The average back down generation of APGENCO thermal units during the last three financial years is approximately 2500 MU and likely to vary year after year. The agency should be capable to deal with the back down generation.

6.0 Inputs to Agency by APGENCO:

APGENCO will provide the information project at pre-bid stage.

- b) Operational Data as required
- c) Any other data required during the study as per the availability

7.0 General Information

- i. Through this EOI, APGENCO intends to undertake a comprehensive study on NOAR (National Open Access Registry) procedures, infrastructure requirements for implementation, statutory approvals, regulatory compliance and assessment of benefits and challenges associated with registration of APGENCO generating units in NOAR.
- ii. Responses to EOI are to be submitted in English only. Supporting documents, as required, should also be in English language. In case of some documents being available in languages other than English, the Applicant shall necessarily provide duly authenticated translated version of the same in English.


